# 1990 SUPER SHOOT

**NORM DIXON TAKES 10½ LB. TITLE.  
PAUL MITCHELL WINS HEAVY VARMINT CROWN.  
TWO GUN AGG TO ALLIE EUBER.**

TONY BOYER started off the 1990 Super Shoot in high gear, winning the 10½ lb. 100 yard stage with a .2428 figure, barely enough to nose out Jack Sutton's .2430 agg. On the following day, with distinctly sporting 200 yard conditions out in front of the firing line . . . the kind of day that Tony Boyer usually eats alive . . . there were, alas, a few times that Mr. Boyer zipped . . . when he should have zagged . . . and that was it, for this class at least. Meanwhile, with a force nine gale blowing, and shooters saying things like "shucks", and "golly jee-pers" after (another) errant shot went astray, NORM DIXON put together 200 yard groups of .322, .430, .525, .350, and .421 . . . good for a yardage agg of .2048, and the biggest margin win of this year's Super Shoot. Considering that the gentleman with the blowout 200 yard win also finished a very respectable sixth place at 100 yards . . . the question of who won the class grand aggregate wasn't all that much of a puzzler. Meanwhile, ALLIE EUBER was putting together a fifth place at 100 yards, and a fourth place at 200 yards, good for second in the grand agg, and other perennial tough Super Shoot competitors were lurking about the top 20 rankings . . . Myles Hollister, Lowell Frei, Larry Baggett, Perry Morton, Larry Englebrecht, Walt Berger, to name a few.

JEFF SUMMERS, who has been known,

on occasion, to shoot up the joint at previous Super Shoots, certainly struggled during the 10½ lb. stage this year. How bad, you ask? Well, in last month's editorial, we remarked that (out of 250 shooters in this class) . . . if they had given out "Top 200" patches, we would not have been given one. To answer your question . . . neither would have the good Mr. Summers. The truth be told, we have become mildly accustomed to such goings on; apparently Mr. Summers has not. At the 100 yard heavy varmint stage he was to come roaring back, with a .2150 aggregate, good enough to beat the .2162 figure of G.C. Shaefer. At 200 yards, PAUL MITCHELL, one of the Dunham's Bay gang, nosed out CHUCK MILLER for the agg crown, .2116 to .2218. Each of them had one very small group; Paul Mitchell had a .237, and Chuck Miller had an eye-popping .150, fired during a confounded monsoon, if I recall correctly. Meanwhile, TONY BOYER clawed his way back to respectability with a third place finish at the yardage, and PANCHO GARCIA was on his heels for the fourth place award. At grand agg time it was a big win for PAUL MITCHELL, with TONY BOYER, RON HOEHN, GLENN NEWICK, and LARRY ENGLEBRECHT sort of thundering along in his wake.

ALLIE EUBER won the coveted two gun crown, via a second place finish with the

lighter gun, and a twenty-first place finish with the heavier gun. LOWELL FREI, who surely has more second place trophies stacked up around his home than anyone else in the free world, was right on his heels, via a sixth place finish in light varmint, and a ninth place finish in heavy varmint. And LARRY ENGLEBRECHT took the third place award, via a fourteenth place in the light class, and a fifth place in the heavy class.
